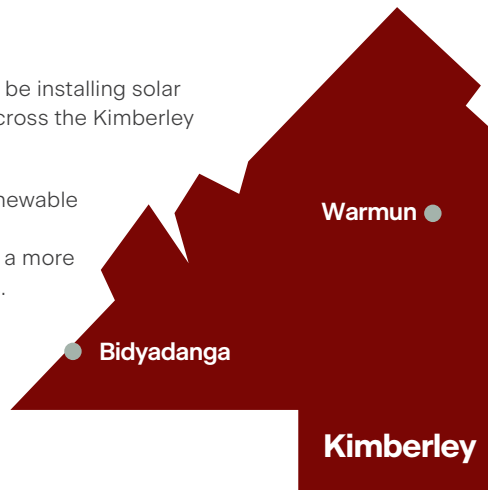
We're bringing a new way to share the cleaner, cheaper benefits of solar power to the Kimberley region.

What is happening?

Our Horizon Power teams and solar experts we trust will be installing solar power systems on the rooftops of around 400 homes across the Kimberley over 2024 and 2025.

We are removing the community's barriers to access renewable energy solutions, and reducing their reliance on diesel generators. This innovative approach paves the way for a more equitable energy transition for our remote communities.

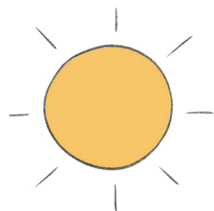
Warmun is the first remote community to benefit from community solar and reduce their household power costs. Installation of solar panels is currently underway in Bidyadanga with three more remote communities to follow in 2025.



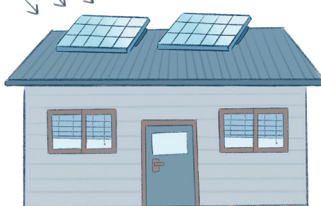
The power of the sun

Having solar installed means the sun's rays can be turned into power. This happens during the day when the sun is shining, so shared solar won't replace diesel generators completely. But more of your power will come from the sun and less from diesel generators.

Not every location or roof is right for solar. It depends on which way the roof is facing, roof shading, how much space there is and some other factors.

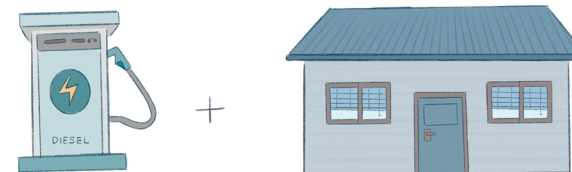
With community solar, it doesn't matter which rooftops have solar panels installed. Everyone in your community could still be able to use shared solar power during the day.

Using shared solar when the sun is shining means you'll be able to use less power generated by diesel. This could help you, and others in your community reduce your household power costs.
